



Item # 1

If this is blank then it will show the symbols as requested in the Symbol look up (#3)

If this has a directory in the field eg: c:\Pd\ASX\
then QM will only source symbols from the c:\Pd\ASX\ directory

Item # 2

If this box is ticked it will display all files in all subdirectories starting with the parent directory in item #1

Eg if Item#1 is C:\Pd\ASX
and item #2 is ticked then symbol lookup will source all files in all subdirectories

C:\Pd\ASX\Equities\B

C:\Pd\ASX\Equities\C

C:\Pd\ASX\Indices

C:\Pd\ASX\Warrants

Item # 5

This feature would allow a mass insert of the selected symbols to be automatically allocated to the correct exchange

The reason for these features is I could select the directories where I store my Australian data – insert the data and automatically make the exchange ASX

Then I could select the directories for US stocks and automatically make the exchange Nasdaq or NYSE (depending on what directories I select)

This would make Multicharts much easier to use with metastock data
